- ❖ child, grandchild** of employee* of the Fall River Police Department
- ❖ currently accepted or enrolled in an accredited college program (preference to high school seniors advancing as first semester freshmen, then currently enrolled college students)
- ❖ a 3.0 GPA*** in 2nd, 3rd, 4th years of high school and/or college to date
- ❖ consideration given to school, work, and community involvement
- ❖ submit with application a 500-word essay describing future goals, special aptitudes, talents, and how the scholarship would benefit this candidate.

Application Directions

- applications may be picked up at Chief's secretary's office (Lori Rita) between February 1 and 12:00 PM, May 1, 2023
- attach **official (seal imprinted) copy** of most current transcript, including most recent courses. Attach essay (as described above).
- return application, with transcript and essay attached, to Lori prior to the deadline of 4:00 PM, May 1 -- no applications can be received later.
- applications will be reviewed by the Trust Committee for compliance with eligibility requirements, then forwarded to the Scholarship Selection Panel for its decision.
- Selection Panel will make decision and scholarship recipients will be notified by August 24. **One Giunta award and one Magan award will be made.**
- public announcement of scholarship award will be made on or about August 24, annually.
- unless otherwise specified, all scholarship awards are distributed at the start of the second college semester

* Employee is defined as an active, retired, or deceased-while-active, sworn **or** non-sworn member of the Fall River Police Department, including Auxiliary officers.

**Child/grandchild is defined as the biological or adopted child/grandchild, or legal stepchild/step-grandchild, of an employee.

***Some schools do not use a GPA system. School officials **must** convert student standing to a GPA score and place on official transcript at time of submission.

Please note that financial need is NOT a consideration in this scholarship application.
